

Sarnia-Lambton Crime Stoppers is offering a cash reward of up to \$2,000.00 for information leading to the arrest of the person or persons responsible for the murder of 14 year old Karen Lee Ann Caughlin, whose battered body was found on March 16, 1974, in a shallow ditch, on a back road in Enniskillen Township (outside the town of Petrolia, Ont.)

Karen had been at Rose Gardens Roller Rink with friends and at approximately midnight was dropped off at a girlfriend's house on Brock Street where she was to spend the night. This is where the trail goes cold. Karen never went inside the house.

The police know that Karen's killer(s) drove a 1970-1971 purple Chrysler high performance vehicle. Factory paint known as "Plum Crazy."



If you have any information about this crime or any other serious crime, call Crime Stoppers. You will never have to appear in court or reveal your identity. If your information leads to an arrest, you may receive up to a \$2000 cash reward. Crime Stoppers does not use call display or call trace.
